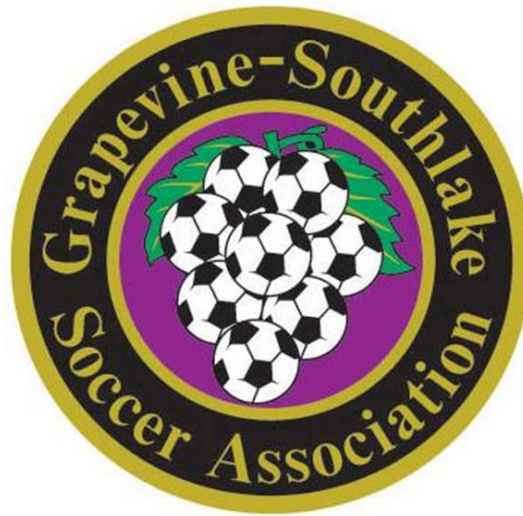

## What must I do before the season begins

- Register as a coach
- Upload a picture to your coach profile account
- Complete a background check
- Get assigned to your team
- Complete the Safe Sport Certification
  - MANDATORY for Coaches and Team Managers
- Complete the Concussion Training (optional but recommended)
- Verify birth certificates of players
  - Email the GSSA Admin ([info@gssasoccer.org](mailto:info@gssasoccer.org))
  - Bring it to the GSSA office during normal business hours
  - Drop a copy through the mail slot of the GSSA office door
  - Upload to your GotSoccer player account. Let the office know.

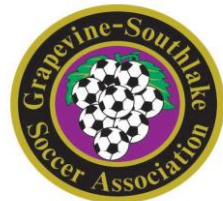

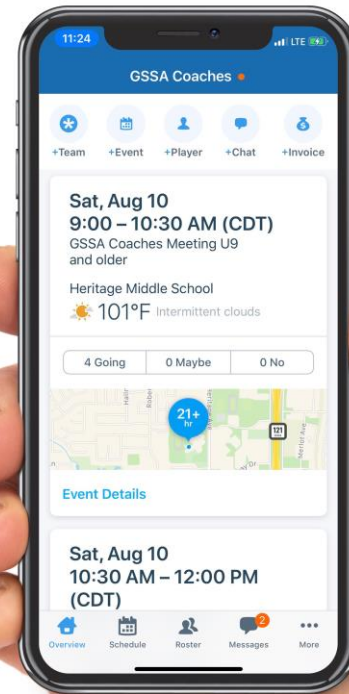
### Coach Updates by text



## Youth Soccer 101

**Coaches receive one practice plan per week via email for the entire season.**

**Each plan includes 3-4 activities supported by animation/video to ensure that the coaches understand them. A printable option is also available.**

**The coach spends a few minutes a week viewing the pre-made age appropriate plan and the result is a confident coach who is prepared to run effective fun practices for the entire season.**

Topic: Passing and Receiving		
<b>Technical Warm up</b> 	<b>Organization</b> <b>Gate Passing:</b> In a 25x30 yard grid, set up many gates (two cones about 1 yard apart). Players are now in pairs with a soccer ball. They must pass the soccer ball through the gate to their teammate in order to score a point and move to another goal to score another point. Players count how many points they score in a minute. Have them pass only with their left foot or right foot, or the outside of the foot.	<b>Coaching Pts.</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Technique of passing<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>o locked ankle, toe up</li><li>o eyes on ball at instant of contact, follow through to partner</li><li>o strike ball solid through the middle, knees bent and balanced</li><li>o receiving: first touch - directional</li></ul></li><li>• Communication to ask for the ball</li></ul> <b>Time: 10 minutes</b>
<b>Small Sided Game</b> 	<b>Organization</b> <b>Drills:</b> In a 25x30 yard grid, set up 4 cones in a square, starting cones in the center. Divide the team in half and line up the starting cone opposite each other. At the same time and dribble to the cone. If a player touches the cone, they pass the ball to the next player in line. The last player in line passes the ball to the first player in line. Duplicate with another group and compete on who finishes first.	<b>Coaching Pts.</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Tech of passing and receiving</li><li>• Pace of the pass</li><li>• At Touch - Directional</li><li>• Dribble</li></ul> <b>Time: 15 minutes</b>
<b>Exp. Small Sided Game</b> 	<b>Organization</b> <b>3v3 in End Zones:</b> In a 25x30 yard grid, make a one yard wide End Zone along each end line. Players will score by passing into and stopping the soccer ball in the End Zone. Defenders can't defend in the End Zone.	<b>Coaching Pts.</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Soft 1" touch scooting into space, away from pressure</li><li>• Proper weight, accuracy and timing of passes</li><li>• Possession vs Penetration</li><li>• Proper angle and distance of support off the ball</li><li>• Communication between players</li></ul> <b>Time: 25 minutes</b>
<b>Game</b>	<b>Organization</b> Play with Goalkeepers in a 43-45 yard long by 35-45 yard wide field.	<b>Coaching Pts.</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All of the above</li></ul> <b>Time: 30 minutes</b>

## What do I need to know

- Make sure you contact your players.
- All players, parents and coaches, are subject to the Code of Conduct agreed to during registration. Improper language and abuse of referees, volunteers, staff, or coaches **WILL NOT** be tolerated.
- Each player is required to play for 50% of the time they are at each game per NMCSL & GSSA bylaws.
- You may not run up the score in any game. Any score with a differential of more than 6 will be reviewed.
- No jewelry is allowed at all – no tape over earrings.
- U4-U8 can have a max of 2 coaches on players side.
  - Kids and parents should be on opposite sides of the field.
- U9-U19 can have a max of 3 coaches on players side.



## Changes to the Laws of the Games

### Drop Balls

- Drop Balls will be taken by only one player. All other players should be 4m away.
- If play was stopped inside the penalty area, the keeper will get the ball. If play was stopped outside the penalty area, it is awarded to the last team with possession.
- A drop ball is awarded if the ball touches a match official and goes into the goal, causes a change in possession, or creates a promising attack.

### Handling

- Handling should now be called, and a free kick should be awarded for the following situations.
  - If after touching players' hand/arm a goal is scored or gains possession and/or creates a goal scoring opportunity.
  - If the ball touches the players' hand/ arm and it is extended from the body (making their body unnaturally bigger).

## Changes to the Laws of the Games

### Kickoff

- The team that wins the kick-off can choose whether they want to kick-off first or which side they want to defend.

### Free Kicks

- Attackers are not allowed within 1m of a wall of 3 or more defenders. If a player is within 1m, the appropriate restart is an indirect kick for the other team.
- Free kicks taken within a teams' own penalty area are in play once the ball is kicked and the ball does not need to leave the box to be played by another player.

### Goal Kicks

- Goal kicks are in play once kicked and the ball no longer needs to leave the penalty area before being played by another player.

## Changes to the Laws of the Games

### Penalty Kick

- An injured player taking a penalty kick can have quick treatment/ assessment before taking the kick.
- The goalkeeper cannot be touching the posts or crossbar at the start of the kick.
- The goalkeeper must have at least 1 foot on the line and cannot be behind the goal line.

### Quick Free kick and cards

- If the referee was going to issue a card on a foul and the non-offending team does a quick restart and creates a goal scoring opportunity, the referee can deliver the card at the next stoppage in play.

### Coaches and cards

- Coaches can now be shown cards (Yellow is caution, red is sending off).

## U4 / U5

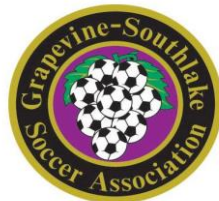
- Each session will combine a 30-minute practice session followed immediately by 30 minutes of 4V4 games.
- There are no organized practice times.
- Teams will look to maximize roster at 8 players and players should play 50% of the time.
- Only the Coaches are allowed on the field during the 4v4 game. Parents must be on opposite side of the field from the bench.
- Games will be at Bob Jones Park in Southlake.
- U4/U5 will play at 9:00am and 10:30am
- Have your kids arrive 10-15 minutes early.
- Shin guards are mandatory and cleats are preferred.
- Report disruptive behavior to AGC John Ferraro.



# Grapevine Southlake Soccer Association

## U6

- **Spirit of the game:** The idea is to learn how to play and be involved in the game. It IS NOT just about scoring.
- **There are no goalies at U6.** Defenders are allowed, but no hands are allowed, and defenders should be encouraged to get into the whole game and not “camp out” in front of the goal.
- **Substitutions allowed** at end of quarters or for an injured player.
- **Throw ins, goal kicks & corners** are part of the game. Players should be allowed space to complete a restart of play.
- **While there are no referees in U6,** we want our players to be prepared for referees in the Fall of their U7 season. Please call penalties and help them learn what to expect.
- **Meet with opposing coach** before the game to agree on details. Games will be at Bob Jones Park.
- **Shin guards** are mandatory and cleats are preferred.
- **Report disruptive behavior** to AGC Kirk Challgren.

## U6

- **Throw-in:** Play stops. The ball will be placed on the touch line where it left the field. The player will kick the ball into play from a standing position (meaning no running up to the ball).
- **Goal kicks:** Play stops. The ball will be placed on the end line near the closest goal post from where the ball went over the end line. The player will kick the ball into play from a standing position (meaning no running up to the ball).
- **Corner kicks.** Play stops. The ball will be placed at the corner on the same side of the field where the ball went over the end line. The player will kick the ball into play from a standing position (meaning no running up to the ball).
- If the player performs any of the above incorrectly, play should stop and the player given a second chance. Play should continue after the second attempt even if the player does it incorrectly.

## U7 / U8

- If no ref, someone other than a coach should be recruited to referee.
- Treat referees respectfully and handle disputed calls professionally (if at all at this age level).
- Be mindful of behavior (coach and parents) in front of youth players and spectators.
- Substitutions allowed at end of quarters or for an injured player.
- Shin guards are mandatory and cleats are preferred.
- Please be aware that slide tackling and “heading” the ball is prohibited. Do not practice this.
- U7/U8 will be played at Meadowmere Park or Bob Jones. U7 will play 4v4.
- Unprofessional behavior will result in A&D hearings. (ESPECIALLY COACHES).
- Report disruptive behavior to the AGC Mitch Wegner.

## U9 / U10

- Please remember the main reason why we are involved in recreational soccer: It is to have fun and provide an opportunity for our youth to learn, and develop a passion for the sport.
- Each coach is responsible for calling in his/her own game scores to the number on the game report/NMCSL website schedule tab.
- Away games across NMCSL sites.
- U9 & U10 will play 7v7 (6 plus Keeper).
- Substitutions allowed on throw-ins, goal kicks, after a score or for an injured player.
- **Please be aware that slide tackling and “heading” the ball is prohibited.\*\***
- Home games will be played across all three fields.
- Please review the NMCSL bylaws available on NMCSL website. Be familiar rules differences between U8 and U9, there are several of them.
- Report disruptive behavior to AGC David Grice.



# Development Rules for 7v7



- Once the opposing team is behind the build out line, the goalkeeper can pass, throw or roll the ball to a teammate (no punting)
- After the ball is put into play by the goalkeeper, the opposing team can cross the build out line and play resumes as normal

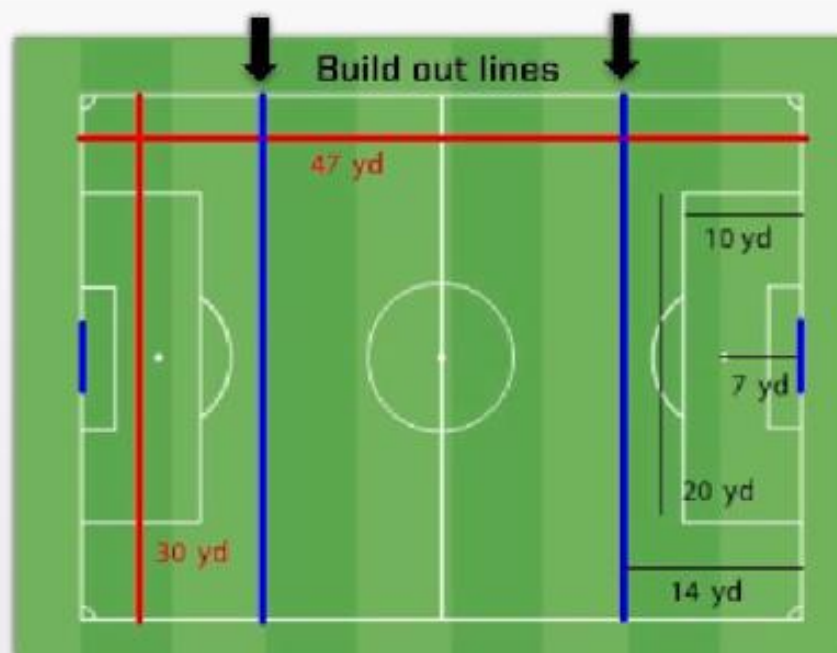


# U9 | U10

## Build Out Line



- Used to promote playing the ball out of the back in an no pressure setting.
- When the goalkeeper has the ball, either during play or from a goal kick, the opposing team must move behind the build out line.
- The goalkeeper may then pass, throw or roll the ball to a teammate (no punting).
- Once the ball is in play, the opposing team may cross the build out line and play resumes.

## U11 - U19

- Coaches must display their coach's ID card at all games! Those without ID's will be asked to leave if there are multiple coaches, and the coach will be suspended for the next game by NMCSL officials. You also must have a signed copy of your team roster at all games.
- Coaches **MUST UPDATE PLAYER #'s IN GOT SOCCER.**
- U11 and U12 will play 9v9. Home games at Bob Jones or Oak Grove.
- U13 and older will play Home games at Meadowmere or Oak Grove.
- Substitutions allowed on throw-ins, goal kicks, after a score or for injured player.
- Please be aware that "heading" the ball is prohibited for U11 and U12.
- All players U13 and older are required to have a Picture ID card (or a picture roster) available at the field for each game. These are to be presented to the referee prior to the start of the game.
- You will need to have the typed NMCSL game report filled out to hand to officials with the player cards (U13-U19) prior to being allowed to start the game.
- Report disruptive behavior to AGC Justin Hibbs.

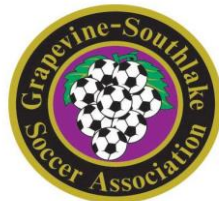


### PLAYER/COACH MATCH SIT-OUT VERIFICATION

As per NTSSA Rule 3.11.2.2, 3.11.2.3, and 3.11.3.9, any player/coach receiving a send-off (Red Card) must sit out the next scheduled game that the player's team is involved in. In order to verify that the offending player/coach serves his/her game suspension, this form must be completed by the coach, assistant coach, or team manager and the referee must sign off on the fact that the player/coach did not participate. The player/coach receiving send-off must then submit this report to the tournament headquarters and/or team's playing league.

Coaches are not to be shown any cards, but simply disciplined/ejected and noted on report (i.e. Send-Off). DOES result in next game sit-out.

Immediately substitute out a player if they get a caution –

- Allowed for that player as it is a stoppage of play
- Allows you to avoid the possibility of a red due to “dissent”
- Discuss the infraction.

### NTSSA Bylaw 3.11.2

#### 3.11.2 Misconduct of Youth Players/Coaches/Assistant Coaches

1. All Member Associations, Playing Leagues and Tournament Officials are directed to operate and keep records on a “CUMULATIVE CARD SYSTEM” for all players/coaches/assistant coaches. Appeals of cards are not allowed except when the referee admits he made an error in the issuance of the card. Cards issued in league play are cumulative during the entire soccer year. When a player transfers to another team his or her accumulated league play cards count against the cumulative card totals for both his or her old and new teams. Player suspensions mentioned in this section, including automatic suspensions “from all NTSSA-sanctioned activities,” include all games (including indoor), organized scrimmages, friendly games, and the like, but do not include team practices.
2. A “CUMULATIVE CARD SYSTEM” in league play will be operated as follows:
  - a. **Yellow Cards** One game automatic suspension for the game following an individual's third league play yellow card. Two game automatic suspension for the game following such individual's fifth league play yellow card. One game automatic suspension for the game following such individual's sixth league play yellow card.

**NOTE:** A player/coach/assistant coach receiving a second yellow card in a single game is suspended for the balance of that game, and those two yellow cards are then added to such individual's previous total of league play yellow cards to determine whether additional game suspensions, if any, are required. Red cards issued solely as a result of a second yellow in a single game will not be added to such individual's league play red card total.

- b. **Red Cards** One game automatic suspension for the game following an individual's first league play red card. Automatic suspension, pending a hearing, from all NTSSA-sanctioned activities following such individual's second league play red card. Red cards issued solely as a result of a second yellow card in a single game will not be added to such individual's league play red card total.

**NOTE:** In cases where, during a single game, an individual receives a yellow card followed by a “straight red card” (as opposed to a red card issued solely as a result of a second yellow) both cards will be added to such individual's

## Scheduling

- **Schedules will be available on the GSSA website on the Game Day tab. Schedules are subject to change due to weather and other conflicts. Please check your schedule weekly.**
- **Coaches are responsible for checking the schedules for rescheduled games and notifying their team.**
- **GSSA advises coaches to utilize the TeamSnap app to communicate with your team.**
- **Rescheduled games will be on Sundays or weeknights.**
- **If you coach more than one team, it is your responsibility to let the Scheduler know. If you coach teams in both groups, you must let your AGCs know.**
- **7 days after posting; schedules will not be able to be adjusted. YOU are responsible to confirm any conflicts and communicate to your AGCs.**

- Games can only be considered for rescheduling for REQUIRED school activities and REC Head Coaching conflicts.
- GSSA will work hard to avoid coaching conflicts, but cannot do this 100% of the time. Please find an assistant coach for times when coaching conflicts cannot be resolved.
- Please check your schedules ASAP. We will provide a form for NMCSL requests. GSSA has no control over the other associations (away games) schedules.
- There are no guarantees that conflicts will be resolved.



# NMCSL SCHEDULING GUIDELINES

## NORTHERN MID-CITIES SOCCER LEAGUE

### Rescheduling Guidelines

1. Each team is afforded 3 requests to be submitted to their home association no less than one week prior to the NMCSL scheduling meeting.
2. Once the season has been scheduled, games will not normally be rescheduled except for reasons of weather.
3. Any “special” non-weather request for a reschedule must be submitted by **COMPLETING THE NMCSL RESCHEDULE REQUEST FORM** in writing to their home association scheduler for consideration.
4. All non-weather related game schedule requests must be submitted to the NMCSL Reschedule Committee no later than half way through the season.

(By game 4 for an 8-game season – before game 5)

(By game 5 for a 10-game season – before game 6)

**Note:** Weather related reschedules will continue to be processed through the end of the season.

5. The NMCSL reschedule committee will determine the validity of the request and make a decision accordingly, either to Approve or Deny. The decision of the committee is final and not up for review or appeal.

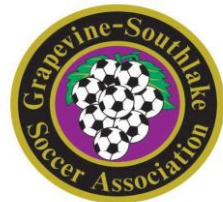
